- (5) Title IV, Chapter III, and Title VII, Chapters II and III common provisions (Articles 41 to 42, 45, 47 to 48 and 105 to 110)
- (6) Title IV, Clearance of accounts (+ common provisions) (Articles 43 to 44, 46 and 49 to 59)
- (7) Title V, Chapters I, III, IV (general on control) (Articles 60-67 and 79-90)
- (8) Title VIII Final provisions (Articles 111-115)
