

Brussels, 23 April 2012 PRE 22/12 (Presse)

The 3161st session of the Council of the European Union - AGRICULTURE and FISHERIES - will take place on Thursday 26 April (11.00) and Friday 27 April (09.30) in the Kirchberg Conference Centre in Luxembourg, under the presidency of Ms Mette GJERSKOV, Minister for Food, Agriculture and Fisheries of Denmark.
